Found, in section 22, an 18" tamarack with scribe, in good shape.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30 mg alvanized pipe with an eight inch plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped soil.

I stamped the disk.

From the monument the original bearing tree was; Tamarack 18" dia S70°E 11 lks dist marked \$3BT. I established the following new bearing tree; White Fir 8" dia N53°W at a distance of 9.8 ft. and The distance massured to a stance of 9.8 ft.

The distance measured to center of respective trees on level. I placed bearing tree signs on both the old and new bearing trees and painted stripe around the trees. I placed a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached near the corner.
