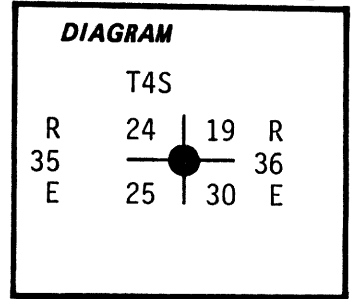


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. R-1

History of original corner establishment: Record of the original survey by Jacob Cooper, Contract No. 397, dated 1881, states:

Set post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 2 ft. in ground on E. hillside in prairie for cor. to secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, marked T4S S19 on NE, R36E S30 on SE, R35E, S25 on SW, and S24 on NW faces, with 2 notches on S and 4 notches on N edges, from which:



A Pine 32 ins. diam. bears S55⁰E 146 lks. dist., marked T4S R36E S30 BT.

Record of the subdivisional survey of T4S R36E by H. Gradon, 1882 states:

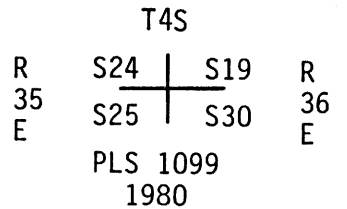
I raised a mound of stone around post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found: Remains of the Gradon stone mound, no trace of the original post, from which: The only original bearing tree, an original 32" Pine, now a 32" Ponderosa Pine, alive and in good condition, with faint scribing "R36 S30" visible on an unhealed blaze bears S52⁰E 96.4 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the True Corner Point in the 1882 mound of stone, we set a 2"x30" Galvanized Iron Pipe, 18" in the ground to bedrock, and supported in a mound of stone, 3 ft. diam. 1 ft. high, with brass cap attached, marked:



From which we mark new BTs:

A 26" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T4S R36E S19 BT" on a double blaze bears N53⁰E 206.6 ft.

And a 14" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T4S R36E S30 BT" on a double blaze bears S84⁰E 115.2 ft.

Attached brass washer, stamped "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BTs.

Placed steel fence post 5 ft. North of monument with sign 54-4 attached.

Attached signs and painted BTs per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Survey, U.S.F.S. Region 6, October, 1979.

Compass Declination: 20⁰East.
