
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

The corner was originally established by Herman D. Gradon under GLO contract No. 452 dated June 6, 1882. The Surveyor General Record states: Set a basalt stone 12x10x8 ins 8 ins., in the ground, for cor to Secs 5, 6, 7, & 8 marked with 5 notches on S. and E. edges from which; A Tamarack 15 ins diam bears N15°E, 104 lks dist., marked T4S R37E S5 BT. A fir 7 ins diam bears S50°E, 30 lks dist., marked T4S R37E S8 BT. A tamarack 6 ins diam bears S45°W, 64 lks dist., marked T4S R37E S6 BT. A pine 24 ins diam bears N54°W, 100 lks dist., marked T4S R37E S6 BT.



U.S. Forest Service corner records indicate that this corner was searched for in 1986. Their record states that no monument was found due to the area being logged and burned.

I found no subsequent record of monumentation in the Union County survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

None.


DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the proportionate point I set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 3/8" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 28" in the ground. The brass cap was stamped as shown in the diagram below.

REGISTERED

I marked four bearing trees. Each bearing tree has a copper nail with a 1 1/8" head marked WTS and 56295LS fastened between the letters B and T. Measurements were taken to the dent in the head of the nail with a Trimble 5601 electronic total station. Bearings are based on the survey control for County Survey No. 032-2004.

A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears N49°19'42"W, 51.38', scribed T4S R37E \$6 BT.
A 10" Pondersa Pine bears N01°09'31"E, 50.31', scribed T4\$ R37E \$5 BT.
An 16" Pondersa Pine bears \$46°08'25"W, 126.25', scribed T4S R37E \$7 BT.
A 14" Pondersa Pine bears \$28°33'41"E, 67.30', scribed T4S R37E \$8 BT.
