At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown, 27" in the ground, from which:

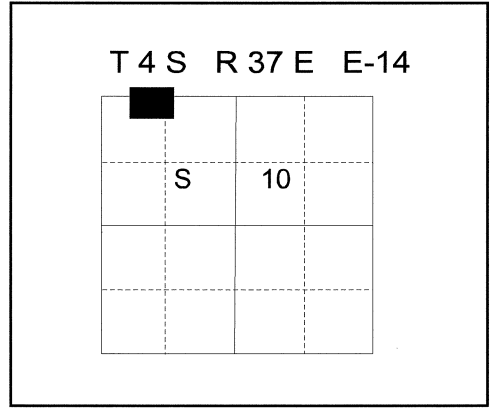
A 17 inch Douglas Fir bears South 19° West, a distance of 10.45 feet, marked W 1/16 S10 BT.

A 21 inch Douglas Fir bears North 32° West, a distance of 30.72 feet, marked W 1/16 S3 BT.

Set a steel fencepost 1 foot West of corner.

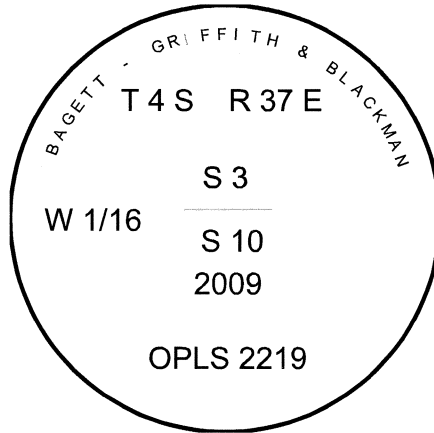

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. Magnetic declination is 18° East. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze. The distance is to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the bearing trees.
