At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, with aluminum cap marked as shown, 12" in the ground, with mound of stone 3 ft. wide, from which:

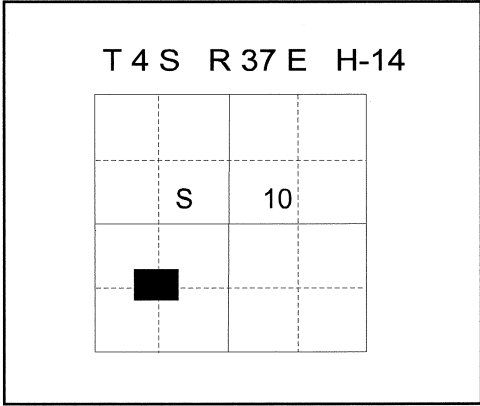
A 16 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 56° West, a distance of 63.27 feet, marked SW 1/16 S10 BT.

A 5/8" x 12" iron pin, driven to bedrock bears North 42° West, a distance of 32.84 feet, with 1 1/2" Aluminum Cap marked NW RP.

I set a steel fencepost 2 feet North of the corner.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. Magnetic declination is 18° East. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze. The distance is to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the bearing tree and to the center of the aluminum cap.
