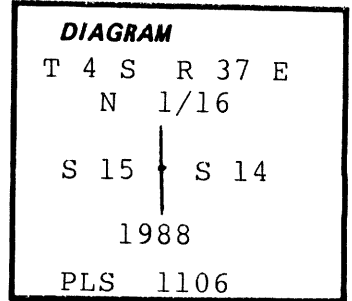

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by survey...

Set a 2 1/2" aluminum cap on 2 1/2 x 30" aluminum pipe 15" in ground, to bedrock, surrounded with mound of earth and stone & 6' steel fence post E & S of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one & 54-2 to both. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

- A 12" ponderosa pine brs N30 1/2° E, 37.9' scribed N1/16S14 BT.
- A 16" ponderosa pine brs S61 1/2° W, 15.1' scribed N1/16S15 BT.

New BTs have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 19° East.
