


History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position established by survey...

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 30" aluminum pipe 15" in ground, to rock surrounded with mound of earth and stone & 6' steel fence post West of corner and attached sign 54-9 and 54-2. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 10" western larch brs N37 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 71.4' scribed C-N1/16S14 BT. A 7" western larch brs S44 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 57.3' scribed C-N1/16S14 BT.

New BTs have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 19° East.
