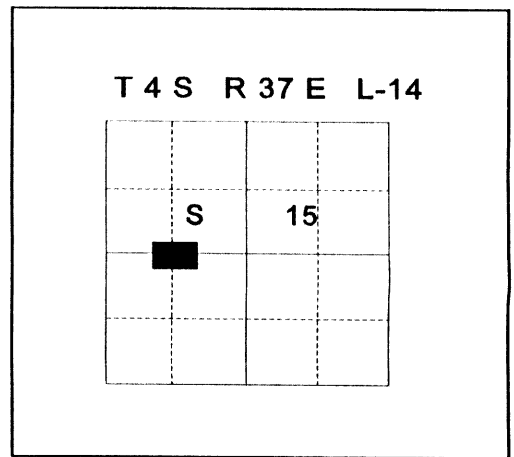

At position determined from survey I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe monument with a 2½" aluminum cap stamped as shown below, 26" in the ground, from which:

A 19" Ponderosa Pine bears N6°E, 109.05 feet, marked CW 1/16 S15 BT.

A 15" White Fir bears S71°E, 57.15 feet, marked CW 1/16 S15 BT.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on June 26, 1996.

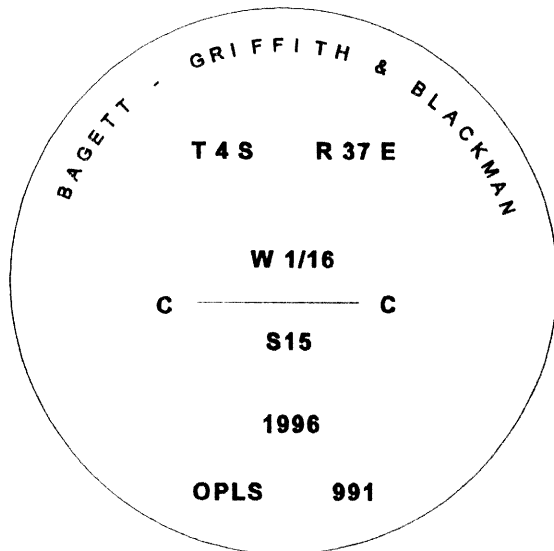
