

At position established by survey...

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 30" aluminum pipe 24" in ground surrounded with mound of earth only, and a 6' steel fence post E & S of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one & 54-2 to both. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 12" lodgepole pine brs $S42\frac{1}{2}^{O}W$, 47.6' scribed C-El/16S15 BT. A 6" western larch brs $S27^{O}E$, 66.9' scribed C-El/16S15 BT.

New BTs have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each BT.

Compass declination 190 East.
