Description of monument and accessories I established to pe original location of this corner

Set a 2" pipe 30" long with bronze cap on top and a 8" plate welded to bottom The pipe set to a depth of 13" and back filled with stone and soil and raised a rock and soil monument around the pipe.

From the corner the original bearing tree is. A pine 16" in diam bears N30" E 16 1ks dist. marked t SBT.

I set a new bearing tree as follows;

Set a steel fence post west of monument with USFS sign 54-4 and a National Forest Boundary sign indicating USFS National Forest land to south. USFS bearing tree signs were placed on each of the bearing trees facing the monument.
