There was no evidence of corner found. The Bearing trees found are as follows. A fir at S10°W with scribe marks was found which has fallen. A pine stump at 368°E 72 lks dist. marked with scribe with BT on it was found.

Description of monum int and accomparies I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 22" in the ground with a Bronze cap on top and a 8" placed welded to bottom. I back filled around the pipe with stone and soil and placed rock around the corner. The pipe projects 8" above the surface of ground.
