

History of original corner establishment:

The original survey was performed by T. Davenport as part of the GLO Survey in 1863. The survey of the South boundary of T. 3 S., R. 38 E. was under contract #102. The GLO record

At the corner point a post was set, from which: A tamarack, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 60° E., 10 lks. dist. A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 10° W., 65 lks. dist.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 32 ins. diam. ponderosa pine stump 42 ins. high, which has been sawed and burned. Part of the "T" is visible on the portion of the rotted blaze. No sign of

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 1-inch x 30-ins. iron pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. brass cap, 26 ins. in the ground, surrounded by a 36 ins. diam. stone mound. The cap is marked as shown on the above diagram. The corner was reestablished from the found bearing tree stump.

New bearing trees:

A ponderosa pine, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 9.5 ft. dist., mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT. A white fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 66° E., 2.2 ft. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

Set a steel fence post alongside the monument, painted the blazes and the scribes on the bearing trees red.
