

## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:


The original survey was performed by T. Davenport as part of the GLO Survey in 1863. This survey of the South boundary of T. 3 S., R. 38 E. was under contract # 102. GLO record states:

At the corner point a post was set from which: A spruce, 8 ins. diam. bears S. 20° W., 15 lks. dist. A spruce, 11 ins. diam. bears S. 60° E., 9 lks. dist. A spruce, 7 ins. diam. bears N. 45° W., 23 lks. dist. a spruce, 5 ins. diam. bears N. 60° E., 7 lks. dist.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stump hole with a rotted 8 ins. diam. stump beside with BT visible on rotted blaze. No remains of the other bearing trees. Stump hole bears N 45 $^{\circ}$  W., 25.2 feet dist.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 1-inch x 30-in. iron pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  in. brass cap, 28 ins. in the ground surrounded by a 36 in. diam. stone mound. The cap is marked as shown on the above corner diagram. The corner was reestablished from the found bearing tree, using record ties.

New bearing trees:

A lodgepole pine, 7 ins. diam. bears N. 33° E., 7.2 ft. dist., mkd. T3S R38E S32 BT. A white fir, 7 ins. diam. bears S. 79° E., 35.2 ft. dist., mkd. T4S R38E S5 BT. A white fir, 6 ins. diam. bears S. 83° W., 6.0 ft. dist., mkd. T4S R38E S6 BT. A lodgepole pine, 8 ins. diam. bears N. 58° W., 6.7 ft. dist., mkd T3S R38E S31 BT.

Set a steel fence post by the monument. Painted the blazes on bearing trees red.

I certify the above monument and references were properly reestablished under my supervision on May 29, 1986, and witnessed by Tom Fisk and Larry McBroom.
