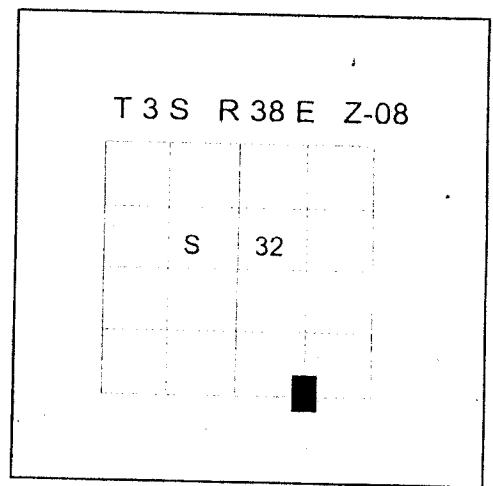

At the proportioned position, I set a 5/8"x 30" iron pin with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground, from which;

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 16 inch Tamarack bears South 14° East, a distance of 80.80 feet, marked E1/16 S5 BT.

A 14 inch Douglas Fir bears North 34° West, a distance of 75.95 feet, marked E 1/16 S 32 BT.

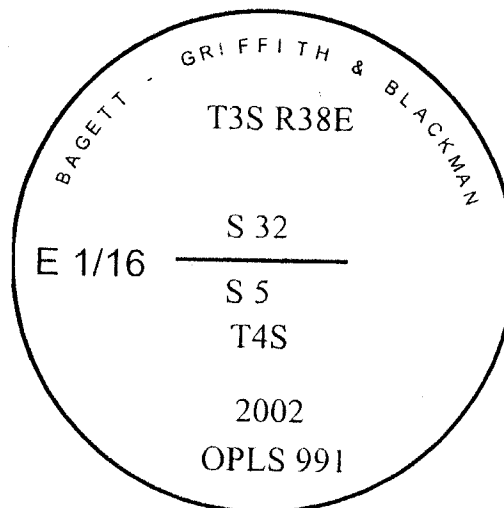
