

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with a 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 19" Douglas Fir bears South 67° East, a distance of 11.60 feet, marked NE 1/16 S4 BT. An 11" Ponderosa Pine bears North 23° West, a distance of 54.45 feet, marked NE 1/16 S4 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 1 foot South of monument.

Monument falls in East West fence line.





I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
