
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## NEW BEARING TREES:

A 15" diameter Douglas Fir bears N 37°E, a distance of 43.00 feet, marked C 1/4 S5 BT.

A 12" diameter Douglas Fir bears N 16°W, a distance of 116.20 feet, marked X BT.

A 7" diameter Lodgepole Pine bears S  $65\,^{\circ}\text{W}$ , a distance of 129.1 feet, marked X BT.

An 11" diameter Lodgepole Pine bears N  $67^{\circ}W$ , a distance of 84.10 feet, marked C 1/4 S5 BT.
