

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8"X30" iron pin with 2½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 7" diameter White Fir bears N 21°E, a distance of 20.00 feet, marked X BT.

A 17" diameter White Fir bears S 8° E, a distance of 9.30 feet, marked C 1/4 S4 BT.

A 7" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S 88°W, a distance of 50.50 feet, marked X BT.

A 17" diameter Douglas Fir bears N 5°W, a distance of 21.15 feet, marked C 1/4 S4 BT.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. The magnetic declination used was 18° East. The distance to the bearing trees is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
