DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the proportioned position, I set a 2½"x30" Aluminum Cap, marked as shown, 8 inches in the ground, and raised a mound of stone with a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ foot base to the top of the cap, from which NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears North 1° East, a distance of 79.18 feet marked 1/4 S3 BT.

A 7" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears South 29° East, a distance of 52.24

feet, marked X BT. A 9" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears South 36° West, a distance of 23.23

feet, marked X BT.
A 12" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears North 73° West, a distance of 52.75 feet, marked 1/4 S4 BT.


