

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground with a 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 7" Douglas Fir bears South 63° West, a distance of 3.85 feet, marked CS 1/16 S3 BT. A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears South 76° East, a distance of 20.75 feet, marked CS 1/16 S3 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 1 foot North of monument.

Corner of North/South/East bearing fence lines bears North East approx. 60 ft.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on May 15, 2018.





I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
