

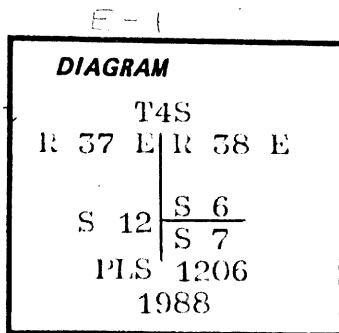
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original survey was performed by T. Lavenport under GLO contract No. 102 dated July 20, 1863. GLO record states:

Set post, from which:

- A pine 48" dia. bears S 55 E, 89 lks.
- A pine 16" dia. bears N 50 W, 107 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a rotted stump, 10" high, dia. indeterminant, bears N 50 W 70.6 ft. unmarked.

A 36" dia. rotted, burned and sawed stump 30" high bears S 55 E 58.7 ft. unmarked.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point as reestablished from the original found bearing trees, set 2½" brass cap on 1½" dia. galv. iron pipe, 30" long, 20" into the ground.

From the corner point:

A 17" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears N 84 E, 76.9 ft. dist. marked T4S R38E S6 BT

A 15" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S 51 E, 45.4 ft. dist. marked T4S R38E S7 BT

Set a steel fence post alongside the monument, painted the blazes on the bearing trees red, and attached a brass I. D. washer between the B and T scribes.
