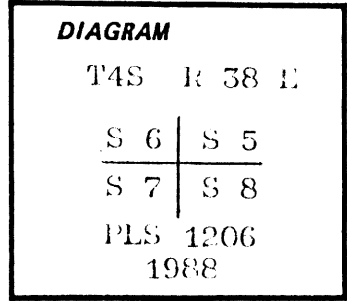


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:



The original survey of Township 4 South, Range 38 East was performed by W. B. Barr under contract No. 388, dated May 7, 1881. GLC record states:

Set stake, from which:

- A black pine 6" dia. bears N 55 E, 5 lks.
- A black pine 8" dia. bears N 50 W, 9 lks.
- A black pine 6" dia. bears S 51 E, 12 lks.
- A black pine 8" dia. bears S 11 W, 5 lks.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found a 1/4" x 2" x 1.5' long piece of flat steel and a wood post 4" x 4" x 4' long with cruiser tag attached, both in center of 36" dia. stone mound.  
From which:

A rotted stump, size indeterminate, bears S 51 E, 7.9 ft. marked with chop marks.

A stump hole bears N 55 E, 3.3 ft.

Rotted stump remains bear S 11 W, 3.3 ft. unmarked.

Rotted scribe remains found lying Northwesterly 3' from the corner presumably from the N. bearing tree, whose position has been disturbed by a road cut. Marked with chop marks and "S" scribe visible.  
**Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

At the corner point previously occupied by the piece of steel, wood post and stone mound, set 2 1/2" brass cap on 1 1/4" dia. galv. iron pipe, 30" long, 24" into the ground with a 36" dia. stone mound. Buried the piece of flat steel 1' North.

From the corner point:

A 7" dia. Douglas Fir bears N 27 E, 25.4 ft. dist. marked T4S R38E S5 BT.

A 6" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 57 E, 12.3 ft. dist. marked T4S R38E S8 BT.

An 8" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears N 7 W, 29.0 ft. dist. marked T4S R38E S6 BT.

A 9" dia. Lodgepole Pine bears S 38 E, 63.9 ft. dist. marked T4S R38E S7 BT.

Set a steel fence post alongside the monument, painted the blazes on the bearing trees red, and attached a brass I. L. washer between the B and T scribes.

I certify the above monument and references were properly established under my supervision August 12, 1988 and witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom and Andy Marlette.
