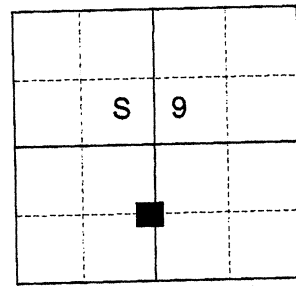


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

None. Corner set by Survey 042-1993 appears to have been removed.

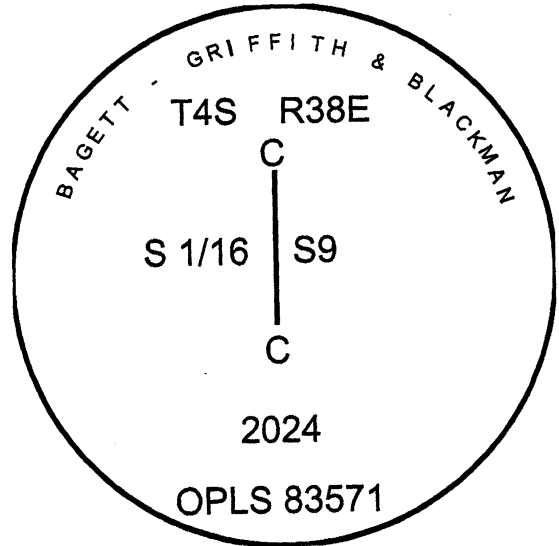

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8 x 30" iron pin, 27" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, with a 1.5 ft. diam. collar of stone, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 14" White Fir bears South 11° West, a distance of 26.90 feet, marked CS 1/16 S9 BT.
A 14" Douglas Fir bears North 81° West, a distance of 22.50 feet, marked CS 1/16 S9 BT.

I use a tape and compass in the establishment of the new bearing objects. I use 14° East declination. Bearings are measured to a brass washer labeled "OPLS 83571" in the BT blaze at the base of the tree. Distances are to a 60D nail in the right side of the base of the center of the tree.
