
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by William B. Barr under GLO contract Number 388, dated May 7, 1881. Surveyor General record states:

Set stake for quarter corner from which;

A Tamarack 16 ins. dia. bears S  $57^{\circ}W$ , 39 lks. A Tamarack 12 ins. dia. bears N  $35^{\circ}E$ , 66 lks.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2" X 12" piece of track, bent, driven into the ground.

There are possible stump holes at record bearing and distance, to vague to be sure.

There is a fence corner  $S55^{\circ}W$ , 7 feet more or less, with fences N & W. This fence is quite new. There is evidence of an old fence which ran through the track position.
