

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8 x 30" iron pin, 25" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

## NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 7" Douglas Fir bears North 20° East, a distance of 3.00 feet, marked W 1/16 S9 BT. A 10" Douglas Fir bears South 46° East, a distance of 7.85 feet, marked W 1/16 S16 BT.

Set steel fencepost 1 ft. North.
