History of original corner establishment:

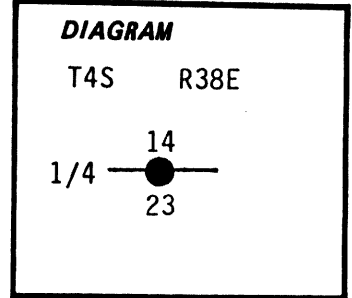
Original survey by W. Barr, 1881, states:

Marked basalt rock, 14x10x5 for 1/4 Sec. corner

From which:

Pine 14 in. diam. bears North 59 lks. dist.

Fir 6" diam. bears S15°W 69 lks. dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found Original SW BT a downed Fir, 18" diam., we open and find scribing "/4S"

No other evidence found

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point determined by reference to the only remaining original BT, we set a 2"x30" Galvanized Iron Pipe, 22" in the ground and raise mound of stone around monument, with brass cap attached, marked:

From which the stump hole of the original BT bears S15°W 45.5 ft.

and new accessories:

An 8" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S23 BT" on a double blaze bears S20°W 79.5 ft.

An "+B0" chiseled at the bottom of a vertical bedrock face, approximately 30 ft. wide and 15 ft. high bears N 77 1/2° W. 22.8 ft.

Attached brass washer, marked "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BT. Placed steel fencepost and "ATTENTION" sign alongside corner monument. Corner is located approximately 120 ft. West of Eastbound lane I-84 about 1/4 mile south of Ladd Creek exit.
