

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner was originally established under GLO contract number No. 388, dated May 7th, 1881, executed by W. B. Barr. Surveyor General field notes state:

Marked black pine 10 in. diam. for 1/4 sec. corner, from which
Black pine 12 in. diam. bears N50°E 11 lks. dist.
Black pine 10 in. diam. bears S20°W 9 lks. dist.

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DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

None. A North/South fence line bears approx. 60 ft. East, however remnants of very old North/South fence line were found within 5 ft. of center of Section line to the South.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 28" in the ground, with a 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

An 8" diam. Lodgepole Pine bears North 37° East, a distance of 7.50 feet, marked 1/4 S19 BT.
A 10" diam. Lodgepole Pine bears South 35° East, a distance of 7.05 feet, marked 1/4 S30 BT.
An 8" diam. Lodgepole Pine bears South 59° West, a distance of 20.00 feet, marked 1/4 S30 BT.
An 8" diam. Lodgepole Pine bears North 82° West, a distance of 23.45 feet, marked 1/4 S19 BT.

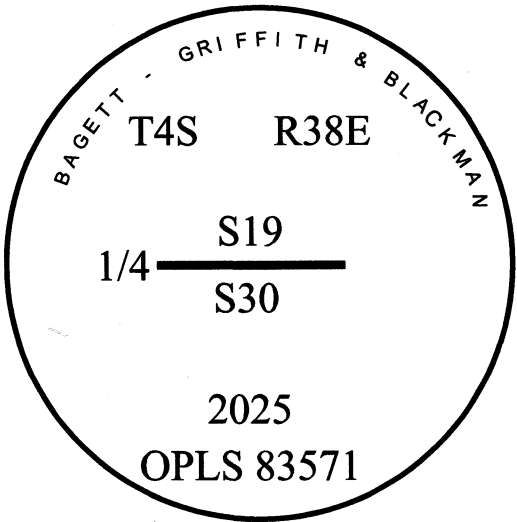

I use a tape and compass in the establishment of the new bearing objects. 14° East was used for declination and measured to a brass washer labeled "OPLS 83571" in the BT blaze at the base of the tree. Distances are to a 60D nail in the right wide of the base of the center of the tree.
