

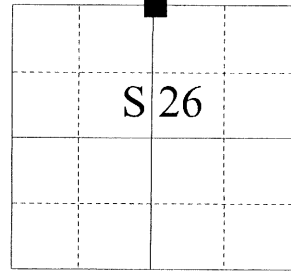

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by W.B. Barr under GLO Contract Number 388, dated May 7, 1881. Surveyor General record states:

T 4 S R 38 E R-19



Marked basalt rock 16x12x8 inches for 1/4 Sec Cor. From which;
Pine 30 in diam bears N55°W 90 lks dist
Pine 30 in diam bears S15°W 64 lks dist

Corner was visited by Arthur Curtis during survey dated October 17, 1898 recorded in the old book of surveys on page number 339. His record states: The 1/4 Sec Cor

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found no evidence of the original monument or its' accessories

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees:

- A 10 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N 27°E, a distance of 59.67 feet, marked 1/4 S23 BT.
 - A 15 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S 33°E, a distance of 56.71 feet, marked 1/4 S26 BT.
 - A 22 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S 20°W, a distance of 10.43 feet, marked 1/4 S26 BT.
 - A 17 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N 65°W, a distance of 41.12 feet, marked 1/4 S23 BT.
- Corner falls in West edge of a forest road.

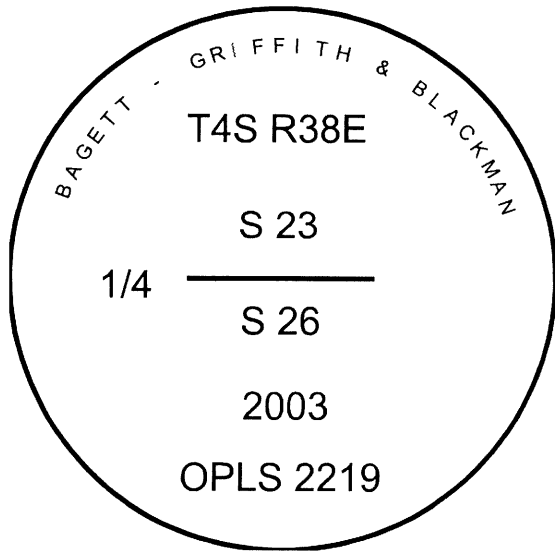

I used a magnetic compass and steel tape in the establishment of these accessories. I used a magnetic declination of 18° East, and the distances are to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
