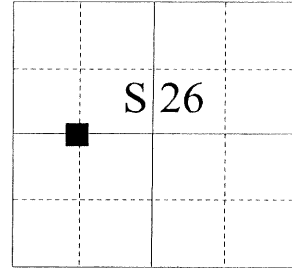

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 29" in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees:

A 12" diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S 37°W, a distance of 25.53 feet, marked CW 1/16 S26 BT.

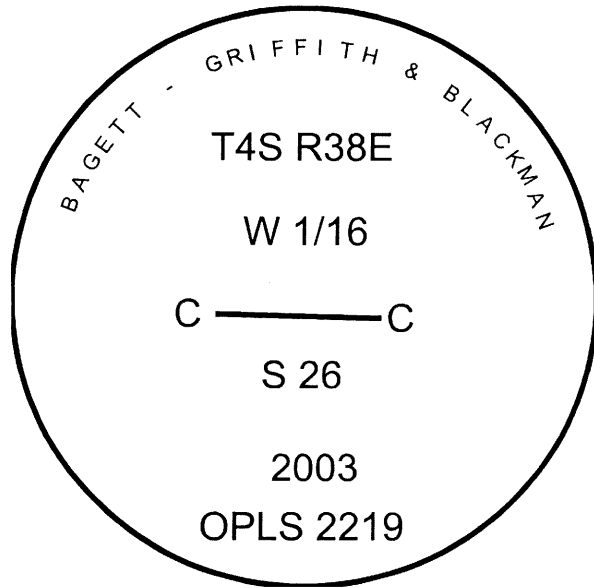
A 7" diameter Tamarack bears N 65°W, a distance of 25.19 feet, marked CW 1/16 S26 BT.

Set steel fence post approximately 3 feet West of monument.

I used a magnetic compass and steel tape in the establishment of these accessories. I used a magnetic declination of 18° East, and the distances are to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
