

At position by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5" diam. Lodgepole Pine bears North 88° East, a distance of 10.85 feet, marked S 1/16 S29 BT.

A 5" diam. Lodgepole Pine bears North 13° West, a distance of 6.50 feet, marked S 1/16 S30 BT.

Set steel fencepost 0.5 feet East

An East/West fence line bears approx. 6 ft. North
