

A 4" Lodgepole Pine bears North 39° East, a distance of 12.15 feet, marked SW 1/16 S29 BT.

A 5" Lodgepole Pine bears South 20° East, a distance of 10.40 feet, marked SW 1/16 S29 BT.

Set steel fencepost 0.2 ft North.

East/West running fencelin bears approx. 4' North
