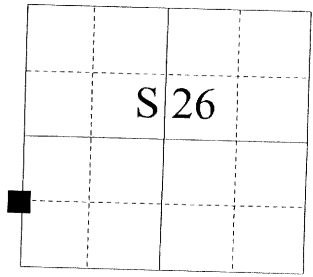

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 27" in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Objects:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap bears S 41°19'E, a distance of 22.60 feet, marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S26 RP.

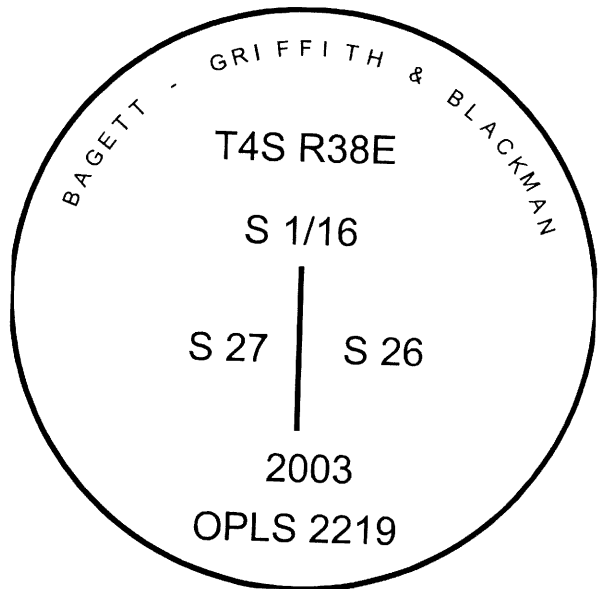
A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap bears S 19°59'W, a distance of 13.28 feet, marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S27 RP.

Set steel fence post approximately 3 feet South of monument.
