A 17 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S 57°E, a distance of 31.05 feet, marked T4S R38E S35 BT

A 6 inch diameter White Fir bears S 31°W, a distance of 76.87 feet, marked X BT

A 15 inch diameter Tamarack bears N 7°W, a distance of 61.94 feet, marked T4S R38E S27 BT

At the position determined by Topography calls of the original survey, set a 2 ½"x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap, 24" in the ground, in a raised mound of stone 2' diam., from which:

A 12" diam. Tamarack bears N 18° E, a dist. of 34.51 feet,

marked T4S R38E S26 BT

A 17" diameter Douglas Fir bears S 57° E, a dist. of 31.05 feet, marked T4S R38E S35 BT A 6" diameter White Fir bears S 31° W, a dist. of 76.87 feet, marked X BT

A 15" diameter Tamarack bears N7° W, a dist. of 61.94 feet, marked T4S R38E S27 BT A steel fences post approx. 5 ft. North of the monument.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

I was informed by Hancock Forest Management on May 13, 2021 that the monument previously set would be removed by new road construction.

On October 14, 2021, I found:

A 13" Tamarack that bears N 18 $^{\circ}$ E 34.51 ft, alive and vigorous with a healed blaze. A 17" Douglas Fir that bears S57 $^{\circ}$ E 31.05 ft, alive and vigorous with a scribe visible on partially healed blazed.

An 8" White Fir bears S31°W 76.87 ft, alive and vigorous with healed blaze

A 17" Tamarack bears N7°W, 61.94 ft, alive and vigorous with a healed blaze.

No trace of aluminum pipe monument or fence post set in 2003.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by record bearing and distance from bearing trees I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with 3" aluminum cap 25" in ground in a mound of stone 3' diam., marked as shown below.

Set steel fencepost approx. 1.0 ft. Easterly of aluminum pipe mon.
