

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 15" iron pin with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 13" in the ground, in a collar of stone 2 ft. diam., from which,

- A 12 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 89° East, a distance of 19.50 feet, marked NE 1/16 S35 BT.
- A 27 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 23° West, a distance of 37.40 feet, marked NE 1/16 S35 BT.
- I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on August 13, 2013.
