
History of original corner establishment:

At the corner point, determined as described on a survey for the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, Dated July, 1990, we set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe, 22 inches in the ground and in approximately 10" of standing water, supported in a small mound of stone, with magnet-equipped aluminum cap marked:


