

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 ½" aluminum cap bears North 33° East, a distance of 13.61 feet, marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP. A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 ½" aluminum cap bears North 56° West, a distance of 13.26 feet, marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NW RP.

Fence corner is 74 ft. North and 60 ft. East of monument. Buried stone alongside the West side of the monument. Set steel fencepost 1 ft. North of monument.
