NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with 1 ½ inch aluminum cap bears N 20°E a distance of 20.65 feet, marked BGB Survey Marker NE RP

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with 1½ inch aluminum cap bears S 15°E, a distance of 26.60 feet, marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SE RP".

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with 1½ inch alumirum cap bears S 30°W, a distance of 28.15 feet, marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP".

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with 1½ inch aluminum cap bears N 43°W, a distance of 28.75 feet, marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NW RP".
