
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Timothy W. Davenport GLO contract number 102, dated July 20, 1863. Surveyor General record states:

Set post for Section corner in mound of stone, with charred stake, pits, trench as per instructions.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found mound of stone harmonious with record position

See Survey Number 034-2001.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position of the found mound of stone, I set a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum monument marked as shown below, 18" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin with aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S34 RP, bears North 9°East a distance of 10.48 feet.

A $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin with aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S3 RP, bears South 72°East a distance of 10.24 feet.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S4 RP, bears South 77° West a distance of 17.22 feet.

A $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin with aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER S33 RP, bears North 83°West a distance of 11.98 feet.


Raised mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.


