

At position determined by survey I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" iron pin with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown, 29" in ground, from which:

#### NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 19 inch Douglas Fir bears South 33° East, a distance of 54.85 feet, marked NE 1/16 S12 BT.

A 20 inch Douglas Fir bears South 71° West, a distance of 21.60 feet, marked NE 1/16 S12 BT.





I used a compass and steel tape in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 16° East. Distances are measured to a 60d spike in the right hand side of the root crown of the trees. Bearings are measured to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the upper portion of the BT blaze.
