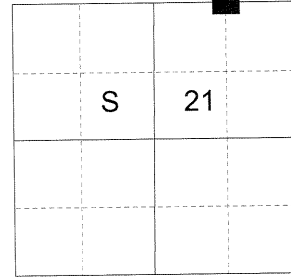

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 22" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, in a 2 ft. diam. mound of stone from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

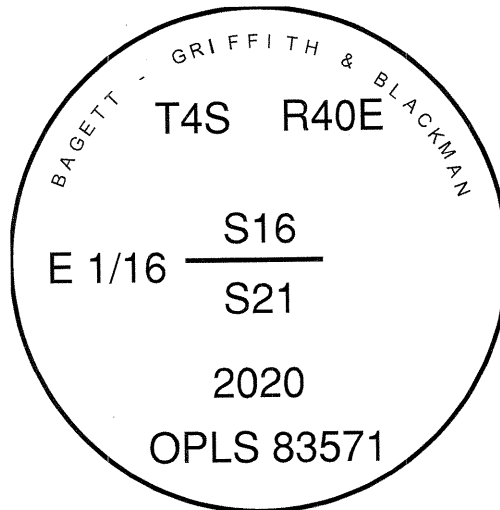
- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears SOUTH a dist. of 20.00 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked S RP.
- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears WEST a dist. of 20.00 ft., with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked W RP.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 ft. West

An East/West/South fence corner bears Southeast approx. 70 ft.
