
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by David Thompson under GLO contract number 103 dated September 3, 1863. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set post for 1/4 sec. corner in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, trench, as per instructions.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

None found. Surveyed position falls in a cultivated field.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At proportionate position I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with 2 1/2" aluminum cap, 18" below ground, marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 3" irrigation riser bears North 17°54' East a dist. of 138.09 ft. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South $48^{\circ}45$ ' East a dist. of 60.74 ft., marked SE RP. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 15°12' West a dist. of 101.45 ft., marked SW RP. A 3" irrigation riser bears North $41^{\circ}20$ ' West a dist. of 87.73 ft.

Falls in a cultivated field.
