



A 16 inch Lodgepole Pine bears S 55° E, 41.32 feet, marked T4s R41E S9 BT.

A 19 inch White Fir bears S 37° W, 52.14 feet, marked T4S R41E S8 BT.

An 11 inch Ponderosa Pine bears N 44° W, 122.14 feet, marked T4S R41E S5 BT.


