
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1, 1879. Surveyor General record states:

Set stone 12x10x8 for 14 sec cor Raised mound of stone at cor



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records. Description of corner evidence found:

A stone 11"x10"x7" marked ¼ with part of "S" visible, in a small mound of stone.

See survey number 29-86 filed in the office of the Union County Surveyor. Description of monument and accessories lestablished to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At stone position, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}x30^{11}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown 28 inches in the ground, from which:

A 7 inch Tamarack bears S 33 $^{\circ}$ W, 16.18 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 BT.

An 11 inch Tamarack bears N 59 $^{\rm o}$ W, 17.20 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S4 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East $\,$ with a 54-9 sign attached. Buried stone south of the cap.
