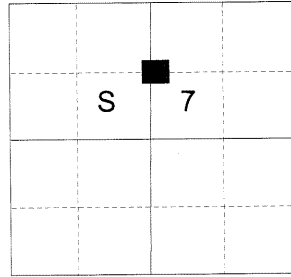

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rod with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 25" in the ground. From which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears North 17° East, a distance of 34.55 feet, marked CN 1/16 S7 BT.
An 11" Douglas Fir bears North 83° West, a distance of 27.15 feet, marked CN 1/16 S7 BT.

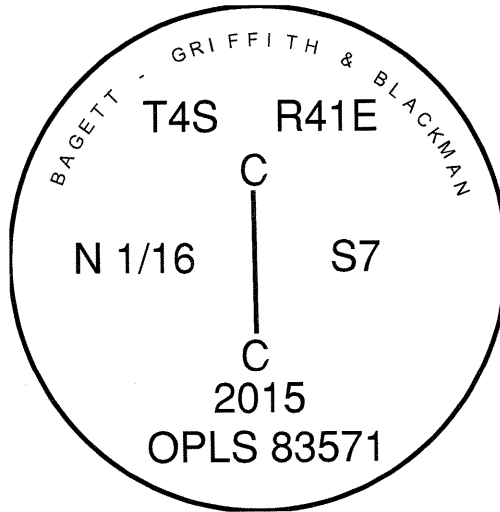
I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot West of corner monument.

I used 15° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
