- A 3" Western Larch bears North 74° West, a distance of 15.15 feet, marked Y BT.
- A 6" Western Larch bears South 30° East, a distance of 43.45 feet, marked C 1/4 S17 BT.
- A 4" White Fir bears South 17° West, a distance of 49.90 feet, marked C 1/4 S17 BT.
- A 3" Western Larch bears North 17° West, a distance of 13.35 feet, marked X BT.

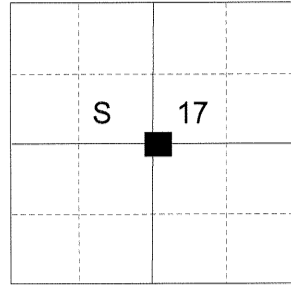

Set a steel fence post approximately 2 feet North of monument.

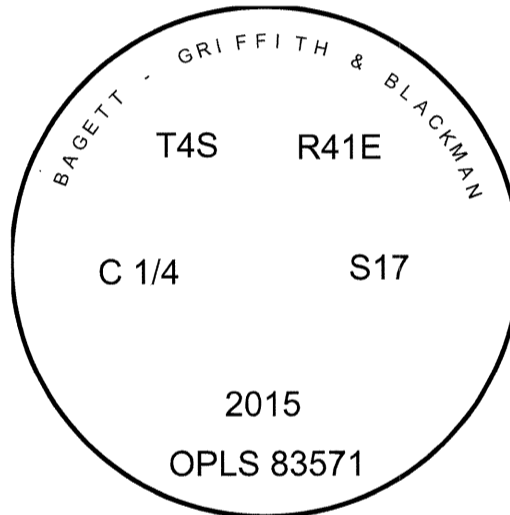

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new bearing trees. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the new bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
