
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by J.W. Kimbrell on survey dated July 13, 1888 and recorded as survey number 41, in the old book of Union County Surveys. His notes state:


Set stone 17x7x6 inches for 1/8 corner from which; A Pine 30 inches dia. bears S77°W, 665 lks dist.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of the Kimbrell corner or it's accessory was found. See Union County survey number 29--88



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the


original location of this corner: At the position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing objects; A 5/8"x30" iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER bears S56°E, 7.65 feet (pin is set in an existing East-West fenceline) A 5/8"x30" iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER bears N73°W, 82.14 feet (pin is set in an existing North-South fenceline)

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with 54-9 sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on July 26, 1988.
