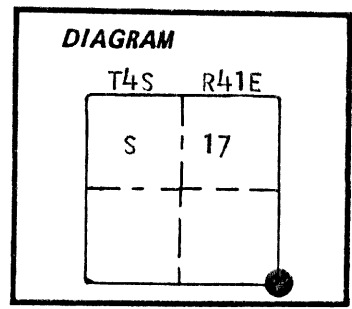


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1, 1879. Surveyor General record states:

Set a stone 14x10x8 for cor to secs 16,17,20 and 21
Raised stone mound at cor



No record of subsequent monumentation found in county records

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 13x10x6 inches marked with 4 grooves on the East, 2 grooves on the West, 3 grooves on the North and 3 grooves on the South, firmly set in a mound of stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of stone, I set a 1 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone 2 ft. base to top of cap, from which:

New BTs

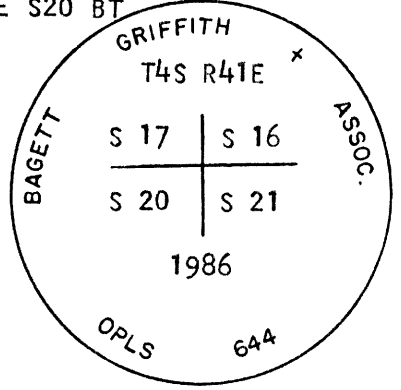
- A 6 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N65°E 14.68 feet marked X BT
- A 7 inch diameter Lodgepole Pine bears S76°E 9.24 feet marked T4S R41E S21 BT
- A 9 inch diameter Tamarack bears S14°W 19.20 feet marked T4S R41E S20 BT
- A 9 inch diameter Lodgepole Pine bears N21°W 21.30 feet marked T4S R41E S17 BT

Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with 54-4 sign

Buried the original stone South and alongside of monument

Corner monumented July 17, 1986
