

History of original comer establishment: Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1, 1879. Surveyor General record states:

Set stone 11x11x9 for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor Raised stone mound at cor



No subsequent remonumentation found in County Records. Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At proportionate position I set a $2^{1}2^{1}x30^{11}$ aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26^{11} in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 2 foot base to top of cap from which:

A 15 inch Douglas Fir bears N 37° E, 72.63 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 22 BT.

A 19 inch Tamarack bears N 84° W, 20.59 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ \$ 21 BT.

I set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with a 54-2 and 54-9 sign attached.

I set a steed fence post approximately 5 feet South with a 54-2 sign attached.


