
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1879. Surveyor General record states:

Set stone 13"x7" for 4 section corner. Raised mound of stone at corner.



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in county records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 12"x10"x6" marked 4 in a mound of stone.

original location of this corner: At stone position I set a 2½1x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26" in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 4 foot base to top of cap: From which;

A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears N 32 $^{\rm o}$ E, a distance of 56.46 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 BT.

A 10 inch Double bole Tamarack bears S 41° W, a distance of 36.70 feet marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28° BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet West with a 54-9 sign attached.

Buried stone north of cap.

Witness: Rick Robinson Greg Blackman Corner set 9/16/86



Brass washer marked OPLS 644 nailed to BT Blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° East declination. Distances to the BTs are to a 50d Spikeset in right side of tree when facing tree, unless otherwise stated.
