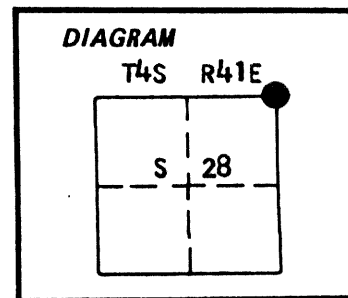


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1, 1879. Surveyor General record states:

Set stone 12x8x6 for cor to secs 21,22,27 and 28
Raised stone mound at cor



No record of subsequent monumentation found in county records

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 12x7x5 inches in mound of stone marked with 3 grooves on the East and West and with 2 grooves on the South and 4 grooves on the North

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

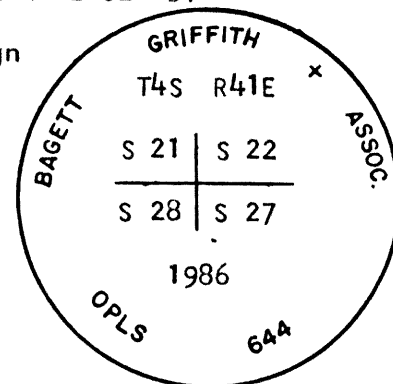
original location of this corner: In place of stone, I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown 26 inches in the ground with small mound of stone from which:

New BTs

- A 22 inch diameter P.Pine bears N62°E 44.58 feet marked T4S R41E S22 BT
- A 33 inch diameter P.Pine bears S34°E 15.34 feet marked T4S R41E S27 BT
- A 26 inch diameter P.Pine bears S36°W 38.18 feet marked T4S R41E S28 BT
- A 8 inch diameter White Fir bears N50°W 10.75 feet marked T4S R41E S21 BT

Set steel fenceposts approximately 5 feet south with 54-2 sign and approximately 5 feet North with 54-2 and 54-9 signs
Buried original stone North and alongside of monument
Corner monumented July 8, 1986
