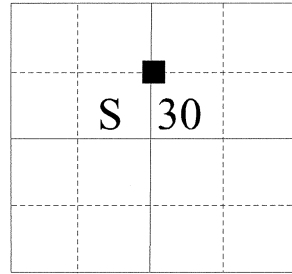

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED**

**TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:**

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron rod with 2 1/2" Aluminum Cap marked as shown, 29 ins. in the ground, from which:

A 5 in. diam. White Fir bears South 32° East, a distance of 5.61 feet, marked X BT.

A 19 in. diam. Douglas Fir bears South 68° West, a distance of 40.10 feet, marked CN 1/16 S30 BT.

I set a steel fencepost 1 ft. North of corner monument.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 22, 2010.

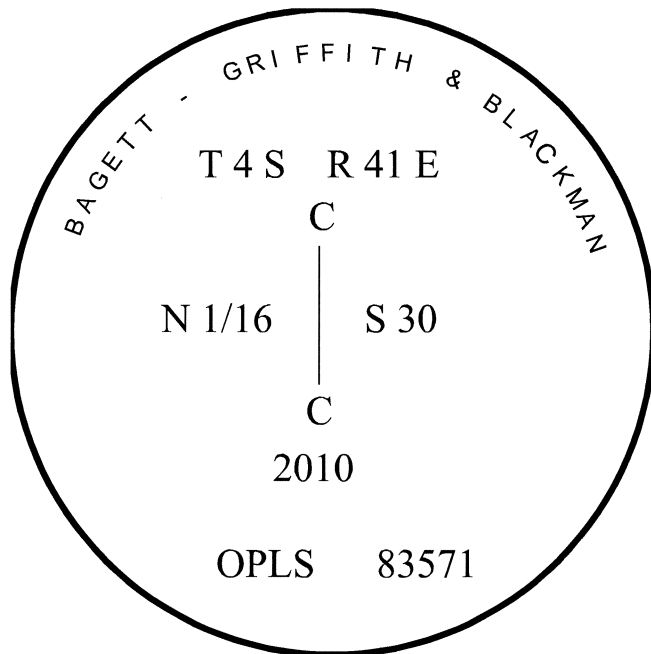

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the bearing trees. I place a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower BT blaze.
